

ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BAXTER COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS,
AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE BAXTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S
DEPARTMENT AS THE COLLECTOR OF ALL FINES ASSESSED IN
CIRCUIT COURT AND ALL COUNTY FINES ASSESSED IN DISTRICT
COURT.

Article 1: Affirmation. This court affirms that Act 1262, of 1995, Section 9, of the
Arkansas General Assembly requires that each county quorum court designate a county
official, agency, department, or private contractor to be responsible for the collection of
fines assessed upon defendants in the circuit courts of the state of Arkansas; and


Article 2: Designation. ACA 16-13-709. (2) (A) requires "that each governing body of a
political subdivision which contributes to the expenses of a district court shall designate
a county, town, or city official, agency, or department who shall be primarily responsible
for the collection of fines assessed in the district courts of the state of Arkansas."

Article 3: Agreement. The Baxter County Sheriff's Department has agreed to continue
serving as the collector of all such fines assessed in the Circuit Court and all County
fines assessed in the District Court of Baxter County.

Article 4: Intent. It is the intent that the Baxter County Sheriff's Department is hereby
designated as the collector of all fines assessed in the Circuit Court and all County fines
assessed in District Court of Baxter County for fiscal year 2023.

Article 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance is to amend and update Baxter County Code
§ 210.00 and be codified therein effective immediately upon its passage by the quorum
court.


