



NOW on this 11th day of October, 2023, a day on which this Court deems to be in session, comes on for consideration the selling of a salvaged 2021 Dodge Ram 2500 by the Baxter County Sheriff's Office. From the records of said solicitations of bids, the Court finds the following:

1. That all potential bidders engaged in purchasing a salvage 2021 Dodge Ram 2500 Truck, who have applied in the office of the County Judge, an ex-officio purchasing official for Baxter County, stating a desire to be placed on a list of eligible bidders in that class of commodities, have been supplied with ample specifications.
2. That on the 13th and 20th day of September, 2023, said purchasing officer advertised for bid the sale of a salvaged 2021 Dodge Ram 2500 Truck by placing a legal notice in the Baxter Bulletin, a newspaper having general circulation in Baxter County, Arkansas. The notice of publication and a copy of said specifications are hereto attached as Exhibits A and B respectively.
3. On October 9, 2023, Harrison Auto Salvage, Pratts Auto Salvage & Sales, Inc, Barefield's Body Shop & Auto Salvage, Inc and Mark Medley, delivered or caused to be delivered their bids at the time and place appointed in the bid notice. No other bids were received.
4. At 10:00 a.m. on the 10th day of October, 2023, said bids were opened and publicly read in the office of the County Judge. Harrison Auto Salvage submitted a bid as shown by Exhibit C. Pratt's Auto Salvage & Sales, Inc. submitted a bid as shown by Exhibit D. Barefield's Body Shop & Auto Salvage, Inc submitted a bid as shown by Exhibit E. Mark Medley submitted a bid as shown by Exhibit F.
5. It was determined to be in the best interest of Baxter County to accept the bid submitted by Harrison Auto Salvage. Said acceptance is hereto attached as Exhibit G.

IT IS THEREFORE the order of this Court that the bid from Harrison Auto Salvage is hereby approved and accepted. The Clerk of this Court shall docket this copy and cause a copy of this order and supporting documents to remain on file for public inspection.

Exhibit G

On July 14th, 2023, this deputy was dispatched to call at the end of Kingswood Blvd in which the complainant was stuck down towards the lake due to a tree having fallen trapping them. Dispatch advised that the caller had stated that the road was extremely rough where they were, and a truck would be needed to reach them. Dispatch also had notified Road and Bridge to go and clear the tree because it was supposedly on the road. I went to the Sheriff's office to retrieve the truck to ensure I could reach the caller. When I arrived Road and Bridge was already on scene and shortly after the road was open enough to get the callers out.

While in route back to the office to switch back into my patrol car another call came out for a tree blocking Promise land road. All my units were tied up on calls and I was the closest, so I advised dispatch I would be in route. Approximately 10 minutes prior to my arrival dispatch advised that they thought it was probably going to be in Marion County to which I replied I would go ahead and check to make to be sure. Near the county line I was stopped by a vehicle with flashing headlights. The driver advised that shortly down the road there was a tree blocking the roadway in a dangerous spot. I told the driver that it was going to be in Marion County, but that I would go down to see if I could help prior to their arrival. A short way down the road I found the tree blocking the roadway. I told dispatch that it was going to be in Marion County and they would need a road crew to clear it. While on the radio I could hear a loud noise from outside the truck. When I stopped transmitting to hear what was going on, something large hit the truck very hard. The next thing I knew the back seat portion of the cab was totally crushed. At the time I did not know by what had happened. When I tried to call out to Baxter County on the radio, I could hear their traffic but was unable to talk to them, the radio would no longer transmit out. I then got out of the truck to see if my portable could get out. When I did, I could see that a very large tree had fallen across the roadway and landed on the cab of the truck, right behind my head. I used my portable and was able to get out to tell dispatch that I had been struck by a tree prior to turning around. I instructed dispatch to please call the wrecker service that tows our work vehicles and get them heading to the scene, as well as notify Marion County that I would need an accident report. Sergeant Zappa had been out assisting with downed tree calls from the storm and advised that he was the closest to my location so he said he would be there shortly to assist. Investigator Schulte had been listening to his radio at his residence because of the storm and came over stating that he would come assist as well. Investigator Schulte showed up first and used a chainsaw to remove as much of the tree as he could from the vehicle. Once investigator Schulte was able to remove enough of the tree the tow truck came on scene, loaded the vehicle, and it was transported to the Baxter County Road and Bridge Department. Photos of the truck are attached to this report as well as saved under my name on the multi-use file at the Sheriff's Office. A Marion County deputy worked the accident and advised that someone from our office would just need to call their department to get a copy.

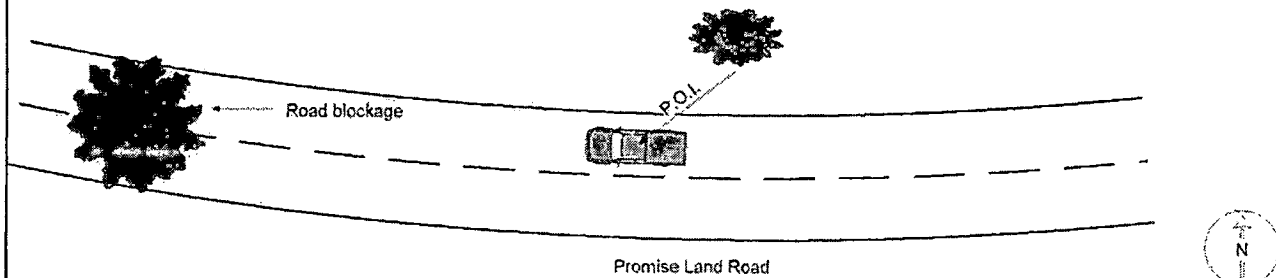
