AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN BAXTER COUNTY AND CREATE ECONOMIC DEVOLOPMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND (4800).

Article 1. <u>Affirmation:</u> The Baxter County Economic Development Committee approved up to \$50,000.00 for funding to the local economy by supporting infrastructure development, long-term economic growth and job creation for Baxter County as stated in Amendment 97 Article 12 Section 5 (c).

Article 2. <u>Appropriation:</u> The Baxter County Budget Committee approved the funding up to \$50,000.00 for supporting infrastructure development, long-term economic growth and job creation. This will be funded from the Economic Development Capital Projects Fund (4800).

<u>Section 1.</u> The Baxter County Quorum Court authorizes the County Treasurer to create the Economic Development Capital Projects Fund (4800) and transfer \$50,000.00 from County General Fund (1000) to Economic Development Capital Projects Fund (4800).

<u>Section 2.</u> Amendement 97, amending Article 12 Section 5(c) of the Arkansas Constitution states the intent of this amendment is to encourage job creation, job expansion, and economic development.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Baxter County Quorum Court authorizes the Clerk's Office to make the following appropriations within the Economic Development Capital Projects Fund budget:

24	will of the citizens of Arkansas and to position the state to act
25	expeditiously in securing economic development projects and economic
26	development services. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this
27	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
28	health, and safety shall become effective on:
29	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
30	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
31	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

Article 1. <u>Affirmation:</u> Act 1112 of 2017 requires that applicants for a private club license obtain approval of the governing body of the city or county where the private club is to be located; and

LEASE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of July, 2025, by and between Trailhead To New Beginnings LLC, hereinafter called Lessor, and Whispering Woods Club, Inc., hereinafter called Lessee, WITNESSETH:

That the Lessor, for the consideration, purposes and covenants hereinafter set out, does let, lease and demise unto the Lessee, for the term beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2028, the following described property situated in Baxter County, Arkansas, to-wit:

The property located at 4245 Highway 177 South, Jordan, Arkansas.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Lessee for and during the term aforesaid, upon the terms and conditions hereinafter expressed.

- 1. Lessee agrees to pay, and Lessor agrees to accept as rent for said property, the sum of \$3,000.00 per month, payable monthly in advance on the 1st day of each and every month during the term hereof.
- 2. It is mutually agreed that during the term hereof, all taxes and special assessments, whether now levied or which may in the future be levied and assessed, shall be promptly paid when due by the Lessor.
- 3. It is mutually agreed that all major repairs, which may be necessary during the term hereof, shall be made by and at the expense of the Lessor, and that the Lessee shall be responsible for all minor repairs. The Lessee shall make no alterations or additions to said premises and improvements without the consent of the Lessor first obtained in writing. It is further agreed that the Lessor shall at all times during the term hereof have the right,

either in person or by agent or attorney, to enter upon said premises and property for the purpose of inspecting same.

- 4. Lessee shall pay all charges for water, telephone, electricity, heating and air conditioning, garbage pick-up and any other utilities of the leased premises and shall indemnify Lessor against any liability or damage on such account.
- 5. Lessee agrees that it will not commit waste nor permit waste to be done to or upon the aforesaid property and premises; that it will not conduct any activity thereon or therein, nor store or permit to be stored thereon or therein, any explosives, combustible substances or materials of any nature, which would increase the fire hazard or cause a premium to be charged for insurance higher than charged for the present use of said property; that it will not operate nor permit to be operated, nor to exist thereon or therein, any public nuisance; that it will not assign or sublet said premises or any portion thereof without the consent in writing of the Lessor first obtained; and that at the expiration hereof, it will promptly and peaceably deliver to the Lessor, the aforesaid property and premises, together with any additions or improvements thereto in as good condition as they now are and in as good condition as their highest state of improvement may have been during the term hereof, natural wear and tear and the action of the elements alone excepted.
- 6. Lessor hereby warrants that it has an absolute and indefeasible title to the premises and property aforesaid and that it will, during the term hereof, defend the same and hold the Lessee harmless against the lawful claims of any and all persons whomsoever.
- 7. If Lessor shall fail promptly to perform any of the agreements upon its part herein contained, the Lessee may, at its option, declare this lease to be at an end.

8. If Lessee shall fail and refuse to pay any rentals aforesaid in the time and manner set out, or to do or perform any other of the covenants on its part herein contained, or shall violate in any particular any of the conditions hereof, then and in any of said events, the Lessor may, at its option, declare this lease terminated and shall have the right to enter upon and take possession of said property and premises, either with or without notice, and evict and expel the Lessee and any or all of its property, belongings and effects therefrom without process of law and without being guilty of any manner of trespass either at law or in equity, and without prejudice to any remedies or rights which it may have for the collection of any delinquent rents, possession, damages or otherwise. And no delay in the exercise of this option by the Lessor shall be deemed a waiver of its right to exercise the same at a later time.
